





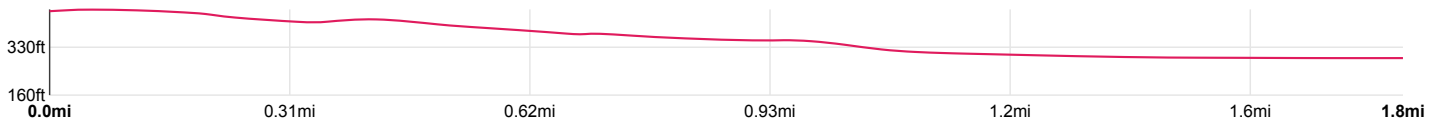

7	<b>SO 401 620</b> Point of Interest The Bateman Arms Dist to next: <b>0.08mi</b> , Bearing to next: <b>66°</b> , Ascent to next: <b>19ft</b>	0.33mi	52° 15' 12" N	2° 52' 39" W	412ft
8	<b>SO 403 621</b> Waymarker Turn left and follow the footpath into the fields. Dist to next: <b>0.09mi</b> , Bearing to next: <b>157°</b> , Ascent to next: <b>0ft</b>	0.42mi	52° 15' 14" N	2° 52' 32" W	431ft
9	<b>SO 403 619</b> Gate Go through the gate and bear left toward two openings. There are usually sheep in these fields. Dist to next: <b>0.04mi</b> , Bearing to next: <b>106°</b> , Ascent to next: <b>0ft</b>	0.51mi	52° 15' 10" N	2° 52' 29" W	403ft
10	<b>SO 404 619</b> Open gateway Go through the open gateway on the right and head toward pond, along the hedgerow on the left. Dist to next: <b>0.10mi</b> , Bearing to next: <b>120°</b> , Ascent to next: <b>0ft</b>	0.55mi	52° 15' 9" N	2° 52' 26" W	396ft



11	<b>SO 405 618</b> Open gateway This can be very waterlogged at times. Dist to next: <b>0.02</b> mi, Bearing to next: <b>93°</b> , Ascent to next: <b>0</b> ft	0.66mi	52° 15' 6" N	2° 52' 18" W	378ft
12	<b>SO 406 618</b> Footbridge Use the farm bridge, not the footbridge as it is very unsafe. Dist to next: <b>0.02</b> mi, Bearing to next: <b>190°</b> , Ascent to next: <b>0</b> ft	0.68mi	52° 15' 6" N	2° 52' 16" W	372ft
13	<b>SO 406 618</b> Causeway Walk across the causeway between the ponds, admiring the reflections of the trees on a still day. Dist to next: <b>0.01</b> mi, Bearing to next: <b>177°</b> , Ascent to next: <b>3</b> ft	0.69mi	52° 15' 6" N	2° 52' 16" W	373ft
14	<b>SO 406 618</b> Waymarker Turn left and head toward the road. Dist to next: <b>0.05</b> mi, Bearing to next: <b>85°</b> , Ascent to next: <b>0</b> ft	0.70mi	52° 15' 5" N	2° 52' 16" W	376ft
15	<b>SO 406 618</b> Waymarker At this point you join the access road to Ox House Farm, headquarters of Corbett Farms. Please be aware of farm traffic at all times. Dist to next: <b>0.19</b> mi, Bearing to next: <b>121°</b> , Ascent to next: <b>4</b> ft	0.75mi	52° 15' 5" N	2° 52' 12" W	368ft
16	<b>SO 409 616</b> Ox House Farm This is a working farm, please proceed through the farmyard with caution and be aware of moving machinery and animals. Bear slightly to the left to follow the track past the grey poultry units, where you will see the track descending away from the farm. Colonel Corbett was one of the founders of Sun Valley Foods in Hereford. Dist to next: <b>0.08</b> mi, Bearing to next: <b>145°</b> , Ascent to next: <b>0</b> ft	0.95mi	52° 15' 0" N	2° 51' 58" W	353ft
17	<b>SO 410 615</b> Tip The footpath has been diverted to follow the farm track around the fields, which makes for easy walking. Dist to next: <b>0.37</b> mi, Bearing to next: <b>135°</b> , Ascent to next: <b>0</b> ft	1.02mi	52° 14' 57" N	2° 51' 54" W	338ft
18	<b>SO 414 611</b> Waymarker Crossing the brook, enter the field on the left and bear slight left across the field toward the tree in the middle. Dist to next: <b>0.13</b> mi, Bearing to next: <b>109°</b> , Ascent to next: <b>0</b> ft	1.39mi	52° 14' 44" N	2° 51' 34" W	293ft
19	<b>SO 416 611</b> Tree Bear slightly to the right when you reach the tree, heading for the long tree line in front, with a gap where the footpath access is. Dist to next: <b>0.13</b> mi, Bearing to next: <b>147°</b> , Ascent to next: <b>0</b> ft	1.52mi	52° 14' 42" N	2° 51' 23" W	292ft
20	<b>SO 417 609</b> Point of Interest and Stiles The hedgerow here runs along the old trackbed of the Leominster-Kington railway. The first stile is quite steep to climb and you have to cross the brook. There is a bridge of two sturdy beams and a handrail. Dist to next: <b>0.10</b> mi, Bearing to next: <b>132°</b> , Ascent to next: <b>0</b> ft	1.65mi	52° 14' 37" N	2° 51' 18" W	291ft
21	<b>SO 418 608</b> End of the Walk The footbridge at the Pinsley Brook marks the end of this walk and the parish boundary of Shobdon. We hope you have enjoyed walking one of the six Shobdon Memorial Footpaths.	1.75mi	52° 14' 33" N	2° 51' 11" W	291ft
